

# October 2022 Master the Art of Inventory Management 5 Tricks of the Trade for Pharmacy Owners

Inventory management is one of the most important elements of running a pharmacy. By keeping track of in-stock inventory, pharmacists ensure they always have what their patients need, when they need it.

An automated solution offers the most precise way for pharmacies to maintain accurate inventory. This is because it tracks your pharmacy's inventory continuously and in real-time. Otherwise, pharmacies rely on potentially inaccurate information which can lead to stock-outs, over-stocking, and elevated expired returns. Pharmacy automation software will assure:

- Monthly re-order point optimization is always in lockstep with changing demand and the preferences of management/owners.
- Optimized re-order points coupled with automatic return and transfer recommendations reduce overstock and dead inventory, lowering overall drug spend.
- Reduced ordering time gives you more time to care for patients.
- Improved fill-rates and inventory turns.

## 1. Match Order Quantity to Usage Volume

- For high volume items, use large packs (i.e., 500 or 1,000 count)
- For low volume items, use smaller pack sizes (i.e., 30 or 60 count)
- Datarithm® offers an Optimal Order Quantity report to help our clients determine what will be most efficient to their pharmacy.

### 2. Buy in Bulk

- Make sure your discount is at least 2% per month
- Carry costs are recognized in the industry to range anywhere from 17% to 27% annually. For ease of calculation, we suggest 2% per month (24%/yr) because it falls in the middle of the carry cost ranges that are published.
- For example: If you are entertaining a bulk buy representing a 6-month supply, the purchase discount should equate to 12% below your net normal pricing to offset expected carry costs on this bulk purchase.

### 3. Adopt the Perpetual Method

- The Perpetual Method is the best and most accurate way to maintain accurate inventory. That is because it tracks your pharmacy's inventory continuously and in real-time.
- This approach, compared to the Visual or Periodic methods, improves the accuracy of your on-hand quantities, ensuring that monthly re-order point optimization remains in lockstep with changing demand.
- Other benefits to going Perpetual include:
  - Financial metrics are readily available making for smarter decisionmaking.
  - Shrink is easier to spot when the PMS and shelf disagree.
  - Reduced ordering time leaves more time for pharmacy technicians to spend consulting with patients.



### 4. Layer on Automation

- With on-hand positions now accurate, changes in demand, costs, and management goals can be established and maintained through automation technology, ensuring that drugs are identified for re-order once the stock level reaches or falls below a calculated replenishment point.
- Optimized re-order points coupled with automatic return and transfer recommendations reduce overstock and dead inventory.
- With automation technology in play, pharmacies can maintain an accurate picture of stock levels, replenishment schedules, and turn rates, with quantities updating dynamically, and in real-time.

# 5. Replenish using Electronic Data Interchange (EDI)

- You can place orders and receive invoices automatically through EDI with your wholesaler to keep on-hands accurate and while saving substantial staff time.
- Purchase Orders are sent automatically from the pharmacy system to selected wholesalers.
- Wholesaler invoices are electronically sent back to the pharmacy and, following confirmation by pharmacy staff, on-hands can be adjusted automatically.
